This course will address insurance regulations, general insurance; life insurance basics; and life insurance policies, provisions, and riders; annuities; federal tax considerations; qualified plans; life settlement; accident and health insurance basics; individual health insurance policy provisions; disability and related insurance; medical plans; Affordable Care Act; long-term care insurance; group health and blanket insurance; government health insurance plans; and private insurance for special populations. Please note: This pre-licensing course fulfills the requirements to sit for the NYS Life, Accident & Health insurance licensing examination ---- \*pending attendance at all required course sessions and successful completion of the course exam. Participants are required to pick up and review the required textbook in advance of the course session to support participation in discussion and successful completion of the required exam. Chapters 1-10 in the LIFE Section and Chapters 3-11 in the HEALTH Section must be read prior to the first class to support successful participation. Each curb-side and street-side space is priced at \$480.00 for each sign. If you should choose to advertise on multiple curb and/or street-side spaces, each additional sign is only \$400.00 annually. Signs for these locations should be corrugated plastic.

Each rear showcase and interior showcase space are priced at \$360.00 annually for each sign. If you should choose to advertise on multiple rear showcase or interior showcase spaces, each additional sign is only \$300.00 annually. Signs for rear showcase locations should be vinyl decals. Signs for interior showcase locations should be on poster paper (no more than 1/8" thick).
