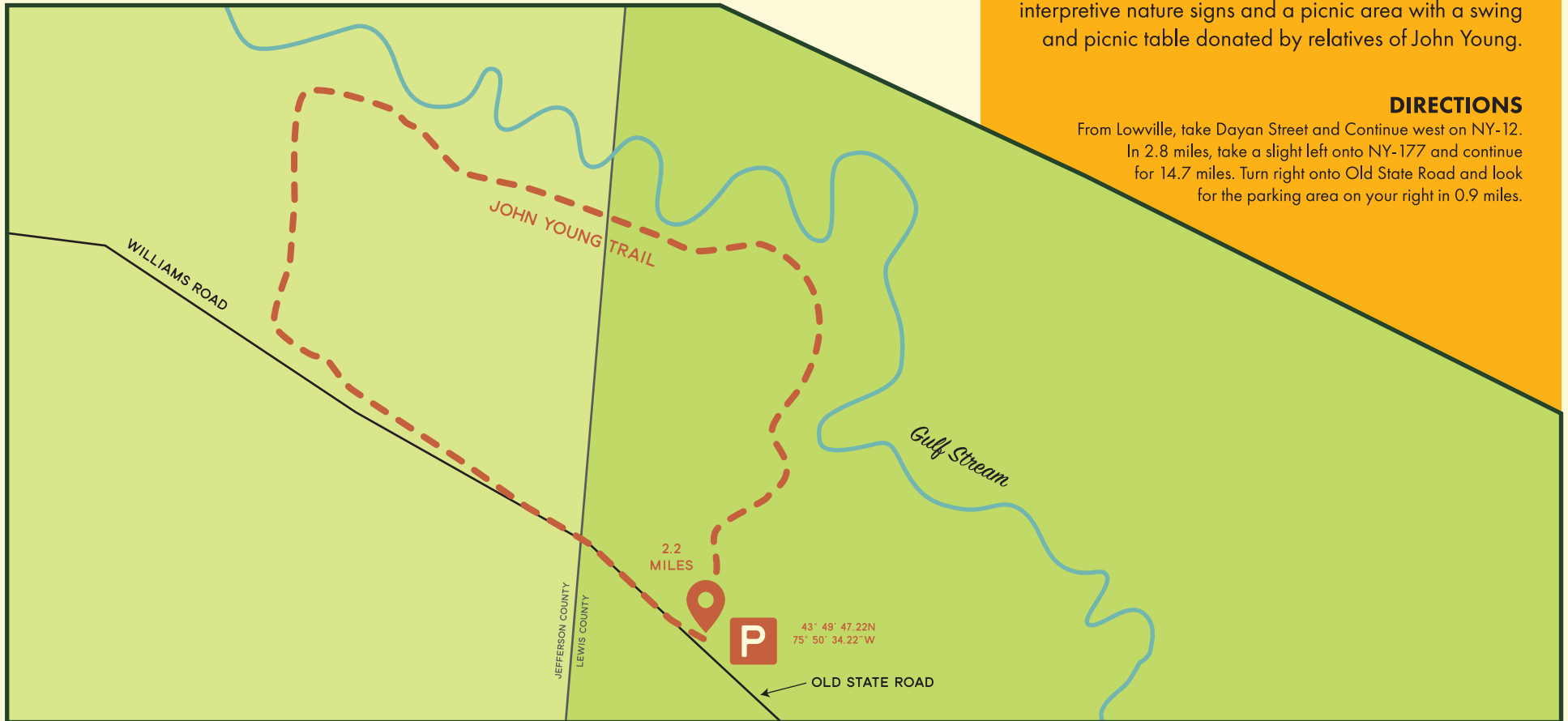


# JOHN YOUNG TRAIL



John Young Nature Trail is a 2.2 mile moderately trafficked loop trail located near Barnes Corners. This trail was constructed by the Black River Chapter of the Adirondack Mountain Club in memory of John Young who spent many volunteer hours building and maintaining recreational trails. You will pass many interpretive nature signs and a picnic area with a swing and picnic table donated by relatives of John Young.

**DIRECTIONS**  
From Lowville, take Dayan Street and Continue west on NY-12. In 2.8 miles, take a slight left onto NY-177 and continue for 14.7 miles. Turn right onto Old State Road and look for the parking area on your right in 0.9 miles.



Distance: 2.2 miles (loop)  
Elevation Gain: 180 feet
