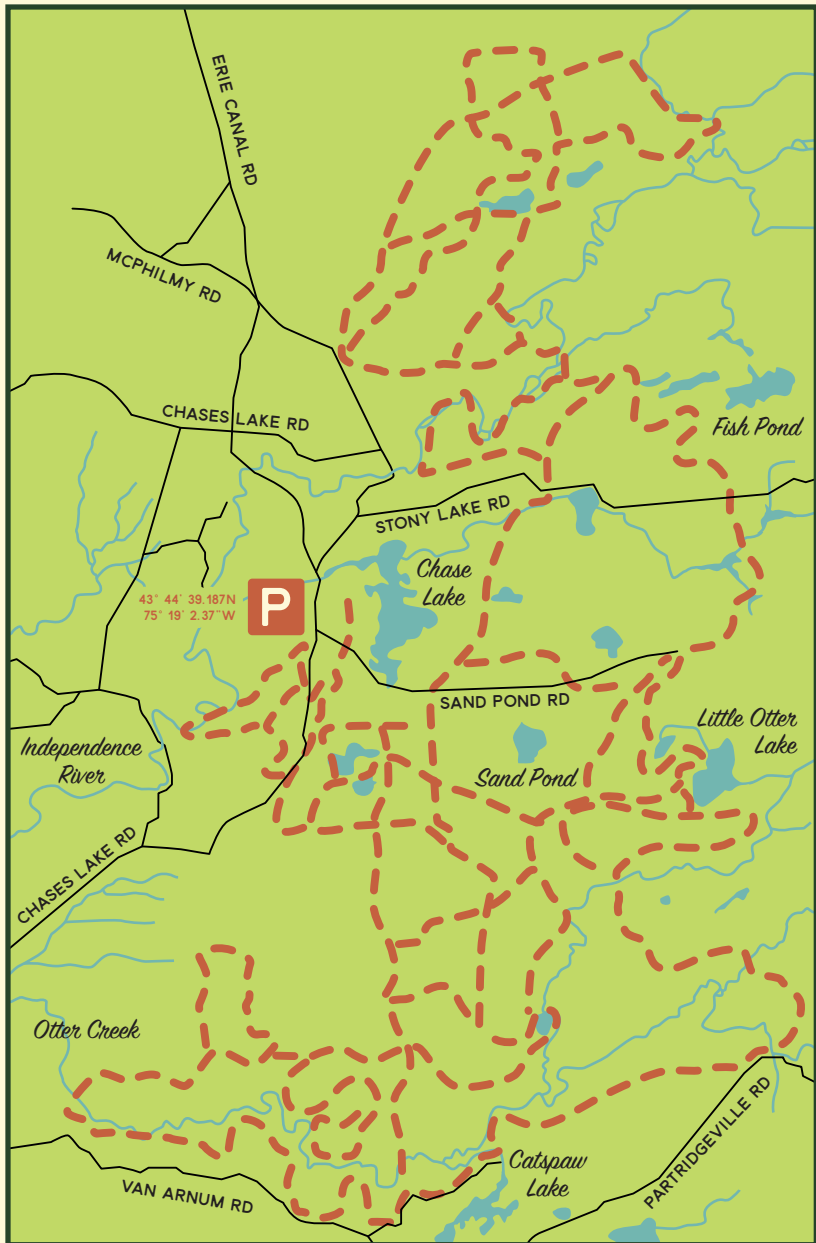




# OTTER CREEK TRAILS



While primarily used for horseback riding, the Otter Creek Horse Trails offer a series of old, sandy roads and woods trails to traverse a beautiful diverse area with the trails winding their way along spirea flats and wooded areas, accessing picturesque Adirondack ponds and following or crossing Otter, Little Otter, Beaver Meadow, Chase, Burnt and Crooked Creeks and the Independence River.

**NOTE:** Parking is available at the entrance to the Assembly Area on Chases Lake Road. These trails are primarily horse trails, so please use caution and be courteous of other hikers and riders.

## DIRECTIONS

From Lowville, take the Number 4 Rd. For 3.5 miles and continue onto the Pine Grove Rd. In 0.7 miles, turn left onto Chases Lake Rd. and continue for 3.9 miles. Turn right on the Erie Canal Rd. In 2.1 miles, continue onto Chases Lake Rd. for 0.2 miles. Turn left onto the Entrance Rd. To the Otter Creek Horse Trails. The Assembly Area will be on your left in 0.3 miles.



Distance: approx 30 miles
