

Do boards and community groups have difficulty finding volunteers? Do you feel connected to other people in your community and Tug Hill? Members of communities are most productive when they feel connected to others and when everyone feels invested in the welfare of the region and its residents. The findings from this survey can potentially benefit our community members by identifying any gaps that need to be addressed so that no one experiences isolation or alienation, but rather a strong sense of belonging. Please take 10 minutes to fill out a Tug Hill regionwide survey developed by the Tug Hill Commission, members of a regional task force, and the University at Albany, SUNY. The findings will be shared publicly and used to inform efforts to improve how residents, homeowners, and visitors feel about the community.
